Installation Advisory IA E-04.6

Affects: Model E-04 Audio Alert battery
Model E-04C Remote Control

Because of the many quality control problems, we have seen recently with Duracell CR 2 batteries leaking we no longer recommend using Duracell batteries in the Audio Alert (P/N E-04.7) or the E-04C Remote (P/N E-05.1)

Battery leakage in the Audio Alert can cause inadvertent activation of the ELT, or constant dim blinking of the remote LED which will cause the remote battery to discharge.

Following is a list of recommended Lithium batteries for the E-04 Audio Alert and the E-04C Remote. These have a 10 year replacement interval. The use of other manufacturers equivalent batteries is acceptable.

CAUTION: May explode or leak, and caused burn injury, if recharged, disposed of in fire, mixed with different battery type, inserted backwards or disassembled. **Replace all used batteries at the same time.** Keep in original package until ready to use. Do not carry batteries loose in your pocket or purse. Do not remove the battery label.
